Status of C63.27

Steve Berger provided a statues update on C63.27. The C63.27 Working Group recommended the formation of a ballot group. Dan Hoolihan suggested that the draft standard needs to be reviewed by the SC 7 Committee. Discussions on balloting process, and timeline to reviewing to process followed. Parts of the process that could be potential done in parallel were considered.

1st Motion

Steve Berger: Motion that SC 7 requests the main committee form a balloting group for the C63.27 draft standard.

Seconded by Ed Hare

Motion passed by unanimous decision

2nd Motion

Steve Berger: Motion to approve that the draft be submitted to the main committee for review and approval for ballot.

Ed Hare: Seconds the motion

Discussion: Jason Coder asked for clarification of whether of not the document was frozen on the date that the main committee accepts the motion. It was generally agreed that editorial changes are acceptable, but primary technical content must be complete. Discussion focused on technical content that was agreed upon in principle by the C63.27 working group but still lacking some text.
